Dr. Scott Dee Emeritus, University of Minnesota and Pipestone Research

Dr. Scott Dee is a globally recognized swine veterinarian and researcher with more than 30 years of experience in animal health, biosecurity and infectious disease mitigation. He served as Director of Applied Research at Pipestone Veterinary Services and was a professor at the University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine. Dr. Dee's groundbreaking research has shaped industry understanding of virus transmission through feed and led to innovative strategies to protect animal health. He holds a DVM and PhD from the University of Minnesota and is a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists.

Dr. Fredrik Sandberg grew up on a mixed livestock farm in Sweden and has built a career at the intersection of animal nutrition, health and sustainability.
